Prerequisite(s): MAT 110 or MAT 111 with a grade of "C" or better, or a minimum Triton placement test score of 8 or ACT score of 24 (within the last two years.)

Course description: Provides an introduction to differential and integral calculus of algebraic, exponential, logarithmic, and multivariable functions. Places special emphasis on applications to business, economics, and the social sciences.
